Directions: Bonnet Cleaning

1. Vacuum carpet thoroughly to remove as much loose soil as possible.
2. Dispense **APM # 19 SafeGUARD DRY FOAM, MIST SHAMPOO** (1:32 / 4oz. per gal) into a bucket or pump up sprayer.
3. Immerse carpet bonnet, remove and wring out or place bonnet on the bottom of the floor machine. Spray bonnet with **SafeGUARD DRY FOAM, MIST SHAMPOO**. Also, lightly mist the carpet area to be cleaned with **SafeGUARD DRY FOAM, MIST SHAMPOO** by spraying a trigger spray or pump up sprayer.
4. Bonnet cleans a 100 to 150 sq ft area.
5. Turn bonnet pad when it becomes exceptionally soiled. Replace when both sides are soiled.

Directions: Dry Foam or Mist Cleaning

1. Vacuum carpet thoroughly to remove as much loose soil as possible.
2. Dispense **APM # 19 SafeGUARD DRY FOAM, MIST SHAMPOO** (1:32 / 4oz. per gal) into a bucket or pump up sprayer.
3. Follow normal mist or dry foam shampoo procedures.

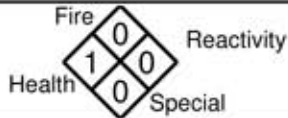
